

Space: The absence of mass in an area around a surface, (ie. Positive and Negative space)



This is an example of Space, because the negative space around the object is what creates the image. The fact that there is an absence of mass around the surface illustrates negative space, within the object.



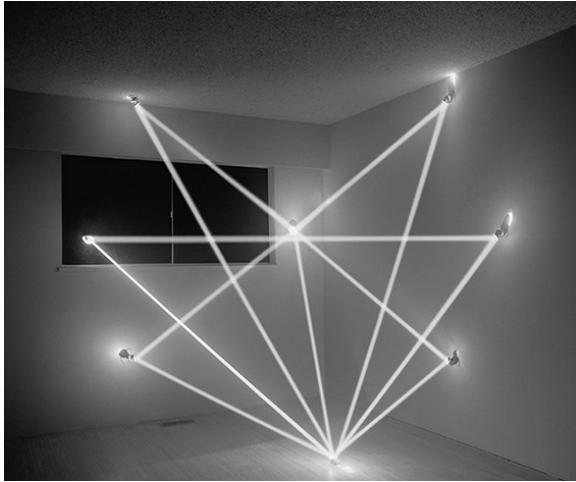
This illustrates space, because one is able to see the absence of area around the surface.



This illustrates Space, because there is an absence of area, around the surface of the vase, which conveys space.

Light: A spectrum that changes the visibility of an object or an area.

he spectrum that allows varied amounts of visibility to an object or an area.



This is an example of light because it uses the light spectrum to make a literal figure of light, that illuminates the room.



This image illustrates light through the use of shadow to create an image. The amount of light being used to illuminate the objects is used to create images.



Lights are literally being used here to illustrate an image, rather than acting as an image or using the shadow of an object.

Time/Motion: This is the fourth dimension.



This image illustrates the fourth dimension because it is implied motion through the lack of detail and the appearance of turning.



Through the use the sand as a representation of time and the motion of the sand falling this image well represents time and motion.



This image represents time implicitly passing, as seen through the aging of the banana.

Unity/Variety: Similarities and contrasts between objects.



This represents visual variety, because each fruit, though the same, are all different in size and color.



This represents unity, because everything looks together and like it's one, despite being different colors, shapes and sizes.



This image illustrates unity and variety, because there are all different components that work together to make everything seem whole/complete.
